MAKING AN APPOINTMENT

Our appointment system is under constant review, and many changes occur behind the scenes. We try to place your appointment in the right place, especially so that urgent calls are dealt with first.

For this to work well, we need some information from you about your call. Please be prepared to give the receptionist a few details so we can put your call in the right place. Of course you can still keep the information private but we cannot give any priority to these calls.



In view of the winter pressures we have been operating a "Doctor of the Day" to handle all the acute calls and route them appropriately. On our busiest day we received 450 calls.

Please try to avoid Mondays unless your call can't wait as you are more likely to get through on another day.

Ordering your prescription by telephone

We have listened to those of you who have asked about ordering prescriptions by phone.
