Our Flu vaccines are delivered to us in batches throughout the flu season.

We have ordered enough vaccines for all of our eligible patients



Last year we offered walk in appointments for flu vaccinations which was extremely popular (especially on the first day!)

This year we are offering booked appointments instead. There are 2 different types of vaccine being given based on age, therefore booked appointments are a safer way of us managing this, along with keeping waiting times down.

Which vaccine? There are 2 types of flu vaccination this year.

Trivalent - recommended by Public Health England for anybody aged **65 or over.**

Quadravalent - recommended by Public Health England for eligible children and adults **under the age of 65.**

PLEASE MAKE SURE YOU BOOK INTO THE CORRECT CLINIC FOR YOUR AGE GROUP!




The vaccine is given as a single spray squirted up each nostril. Not only is it needle-free (a big advantage for children) the nasal spray is quick and painless. It is absorbed very quickly and still works even if, after the vaccination, your child develops a runny nose, sneezes or blows their nose.



Who is eligible to have the nasal vaccine at the surgery?

- Children aged 2 and 3 on 31st August 2018 (born between 1st September 2014—31st August 2016).
- Children aged 2 to 17 with long term health conditions such as diabetes.
- Children between the ages of 6 months and 2 years who are at high risk from flu are offered the annual flu injection.





All children will receive a party bag during the clinics for being so brave!

Vaccinating children also protects others that are vulnerable to flu, such as babies, older people, pregnant women and people with serious long-term illnesses.
