

From 1st August 2020, the government will no longer be advising people in England who are at high risk from coronavirus to shield.

With this in mind we are really pleased to announce the **re-opening of Parkhill Surgery** to all of our patients who do not have symptoms of Coronavirus **from Monday 3rd August**.

The door at Parkhill will be unlocked and patients will be able to choose to attend either Parkhill Surgery or Pembroke Surgery. We will be taking patient temperatures on arrival, so ask any visitors to be seen by a receptionist before entering the waiting room.


Everybody should be taking particular care to follow social distancing guidelines. We ask all patients attending either Pembroke or

TIME TO BOOK YOUR FLU APPOINTMENT!



Its that time of year again and this year more than ever the flu vaccination is recommended. Flu appointments will be available to book from 12 o clock lunchtime on Monday 3rd August.

Our Adult Flu clinics will be starting week commencing 14th September and run weekday mornings at Parkhill Surgery, along with weekend clinics at St Pauls Church Hall in Preston, Paignton where we are able to offer safe social distancing measures for the high numbers of patients we are expecting.

The flu vaccine will be given by appointment only and can be booked online using Patient Access or the NHS App. For patients without access to a computer, please contact us on our surgery telephone number choosing option 1.

Following the department of health guidelines, we will initially only be offering the flu vaccine to "at risk" patients & those over 65. If you are in the new cohort of 50-64 year olds, we cannot currently book you in. You will be invited later in the season for a vaccination.

We are expecting our child vaccines in early September, once we have confirmation of this we will send a text message to those eligible with an invitation to book an appointment.

If a member of your family is housebound we would really appreciate it if you could bring them to the surgery for their vaccination, we have so many to do this year that this would help us.

Please note: due to the high demand expected we are not able to give the vaccine to those patients who are <u>not</u> eligible.

We urge you to book an appointment as soon as you can!

Electronic Prescription Service Phase 4

From Monday 3rd August we are switching to EPS4, this means that ALL prescriptions will be processed electronically. If you do not have a nominated pharmacy, you will be given a token which looks like a prescription but doesn't need to be signed by the GP as it has already been 'signed' electronically. You can take this token to any pharmacy and they will be able to dispense the medication for you.

We encourage patients to sign up for online access where you can request medication, add or change a nominated pharmacy and book appointments. Go to www.patientaccess.com to sign up.

Please continue to order your prescription medication when it is due and not earlier as doing so could impact pharmacy supply chains.


