Flu vaccinations

Winter will soon be fast approaching and we highly recommend our patients that are eligible for their flu vaccination secure their booking. We have vaccines reserved for our patients so if you are eligible, please book in to protect yourself and to support us as a practice. Cases of Flu reached very high rates last winter so its important to protect yourself and your family.

RSV vaccinations

We are also continuing with our RSV (respiratory syncytial virus) vaccination programme for pregnant women, all patients turning 75 and patients between the ages of 75-79.


